Honors Project Guidelines and Dates

*Submit this completed form (front and back, as appropriate) to the Academic Affairs Committee no later than September 15 of the year in which the project will be completed.*

1. Student must prepare a written project proposal: a 2-3 paragraph summary of the project and should address the 4 required elements of an Honors Project:

Research:	in-depth study of the topic
Writing:	a written report/research paper on the topic; an average length is normally 15 - 20 pages
Final Product:	depends on the topic—for example, this could be a science project, a harp recital, or a bound copy of the research paper
Public Presentation:	For example, this could be a presentation of science experiment results to the appropriate science class, a music recital, a presentation in chapel or in faculty meeting, etc.

*It is **EXPECTED** that students planning for a project have a clearly defined area of interest and that they have read extensively in that area. Being well read defines an honors student. Hence, they do not say, "Tell me what I'm interested in."*

2. If the project is approved, a three-member faculty committee is appointed to guide the student through the research and writing experience. This will normally include the student's advisor, the academic department teacher, and an English teacher.
