Pick Me

Pick me! Pick me! Those two words are so famous on most any elementary playground. Whether it is a kickball game or a spirited round of hide-and-seek, everyone wants to be chosen, picked or selected. Being chosen to serve on a team brings self-confidence and assurance—we want someone to "want" us.

Since the Bible first speaks of the Israelites as God's chosen people, many of us have misconstrued this to mean that God does not choose anyone else. The good news is that God chooses many people to serve on His team. If you read the first chapter of Isaiah, you will see that He chooses youth to represent Him. Earlier in the Bible, if you read in the book of Numbers Chapter 22, God uses a mule to speak for Him. If God can use a mule to speak for Him, He can select anyone or anything to accomplish His will, and rather than calling the qualified, He qualifies the called.

Even if you have never had the "privilege" of being chosen first for a playground game, know that you

have been chosen first in the most important of all "games", that of life. God chooses YOU! He wants you on His team. You are His first pick. Are you willing and ready to work on His squad? Are you dedicated to serving on his squadron? He clearly states that He wants us on his team.

Since we have been chosen by Him, the question is, will you serve on His team? If your answer is yes, I ask that you say this verse "out loud". Claim this promised commitment to Jesus found in the book of Psalms: "My choice is you, GOD, first and only. And now I find I'm your choice! You set me up with a house and yard. And then you made me your heir!" (Psalms 16:5-6).


