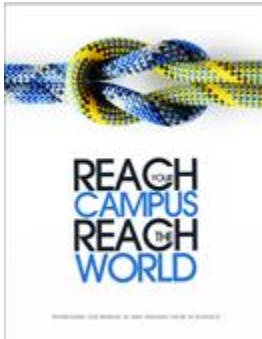

2. Find out whether you qualify for the income-based repayment.
3. Consider deferment or forbearance – If you are unemployed, still in school, or experiencing economic hardship, you can apply to defer the loan for up to three years.
4. Extend your payment term.
