## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS CHECKLIST

- Official college transcripts (if you are a transfer student)

## APPLICATION AND APPLICATION FEE

Complete (by typing or writing in ink) and sign this application, then submit it with the required non-refundable \$30 (U.S.) application fee. Please make your check or money order payable to: **Andrews University Undergraduate Admissions**.

## TRANSCRIPTS

Submit official transcript(s) from the secondary school (high school or academy) that you graduated from as well as any college or university you attended or received credit. Please send transcripts directly to the Andrews University Undergraduate Admissions Office at the address on the attached forms. These transcript request forms should be given directly to the registrar(s) of the high school you graduated from and/or colleges or universities you attended.

## ADMISSIONS GUIDELINES

- At least a 2.25 cumulative high school and/or college GPA is required for admission to Andrews University; or, an overall GED score of at least the 50th percentile.

## ADMISSIONS GUIDELINES continued

- Entering freshmen must be a high school graduate or equivalent (with less than 24 credits of college level coursework after high school graduation): ACT/SAT composite and individual scores of at least the 50th percentile (for good and regular admission).
- Transfer students (more than 24 credits of college level coursework after high school graduation): ACT/SAT tests are recommended, but not required.
- Homeschooled students: Please explore our complete requirements and guidelines at [www.andrews.edu/homeschool/](http://www.andrews.edu/homeschool/).
- International students: Transcripts and exam scores will be evaluated in accordance with published academic equivalency guidelines for the country where you studied.
- English Proficiency: If English is not your first language, you will need to meet English proficiency requirements before you can enroll as a full-time Andrews University student, as outlined online at: [www.andrews.edu/go/ciep/](http://www.andrews.edu/go/ciep/). Courses in our Intensive English Program on campus are available if needed.

## ADMISSION STATUS

Your application, academic records and test scores will be reviewed by the Undergraduate Admissions Committee. Upon admission, we'll share with you the steps you'll need to take to enroll in classes as a student at Andrews University. In some cases, these steps may include additional required coursework or retaking of standardized tests to better prepare you for success at Andrews University.

Additionally, some transfer students who do not meet the GPA requirement of 2.25 or above, but who show significant potential, will be admitted on a probationary status.

In some rare cases, students who do not meet the university's undergraduate admissions standards will be denied admission to Andrews University. In these cases, students will receive a letter outlining the standards that were not met, and the alternatives open to the student for re-application in the future (including improved test scores or successfully-completed college level coursework).

## ADMISSIONS STATUS continued

For priority consideration of your application, it should be submitted two months or more before your semester of study begins.
