## OUR MISSION

### WHY A MASTER OF SCIENCE IN NURSING EDUCATION?

In many areas around the nation there is an emergent scarcity of nurse educators. Nursing enrollment in schools around the country has dropped significantly over the past few years, in part, because there simply are not enough nurse educators to teach them—nearly 40% of nursing programs are suffering faculty shortages. As such, there is a growing demand for individuals with graduate degrees who can enter faculty positions to educate, train, and assist in the development of future nurses. Beyond that, the MS in Nursing Education actually provides significant flexibility because of the demand for graduate-level educated nurses in the job market. Basically, wherever nurses, clients, or students need to be trained, nurse educators are needed.

### WHY A MASTER OF SCIENCE IN NURSING EDUCATION FROM ANDREWS UNIVERSITY?

The nursing program at Andrews stands as one of the most impressive in the region, and is considered among the top Schools of Nursing in the State of Michigan. Our program is the only one in Southwest Michigan that has had approval from the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission for over 30 years. Even more impressive is the report by the American Nurses Credentialing Center that Andrews University graduate-level nursing students received an unprecedented 100% pass rate on their certification board exams.

Andrews University's Department of Nursing continues to move forward in its offering of high quality education with a unique, newly developed online Masters-level program in Nursing Education. The online program stands unique among Seventh-day Adventist Universities and is the only such program offered in the Southwest Michigan region. This curriculum prepares nurses to educate others using principles of the Master Teacher and Healer, Jesus Christ.

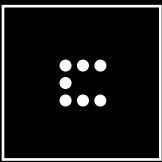
Beyond all that, the Nursing faculty at Andrews University has been at the forefront of Distance Learning for 15 years and is experienced in running effective, efficient, and highly regarded online classes.

A few more points to consider:

- **Earn Your Degree While Earning a Living.** You can "attend class" any time, anywhere you have access to a personal computer. Take one class per month, up to three classes per semester, whatever works best for you.
- **Complete Your Degree in as Little as Two Years.** With just 38 credits, in two years you can find yourself teaching in an academic, clinical, or community setting.
- **Receive Financial Assistance or Scholarships.** Because of the shortage of nurse educators, state, federal, and professional organizations have provided funding for masters in nursing education degrees.
- **Graduate From a Nationally Recognized Academic Institution.** This masters program is based upon the National League for Nursing Core Competencies for Nurse Educators.
