Distance Learning Program

While many students supplement their on-campus studies with an extra distance learning class or online course, there are numerous full-degree programs offered through Andrews University that may be earned from the comforts of home. Whether you are at home, abroad, or on the Andrews campus, we are here to ensure that you have the cutting edge you need to succeed in your educational endeavors. Correspondence Programs

The College of Arts and Sciences, through a partnership with Home Study International, allows students to pursue their undergraduate degree or supplement their program elsewhere without being confined exclusively to class schedules or to a campus. Students can live anywhere, move anytime without interfering with course work, start classes any time during the year, and set their own pace of study. Four degrees are currently offered through the AU-HSI partnership:
