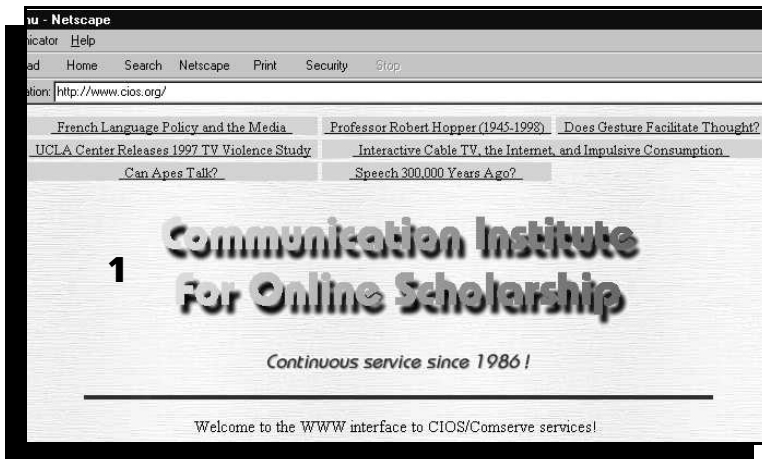


# Sample Search for Communication Institute for Online Scholarship (CIOS)

### 1. CIOS home page heading

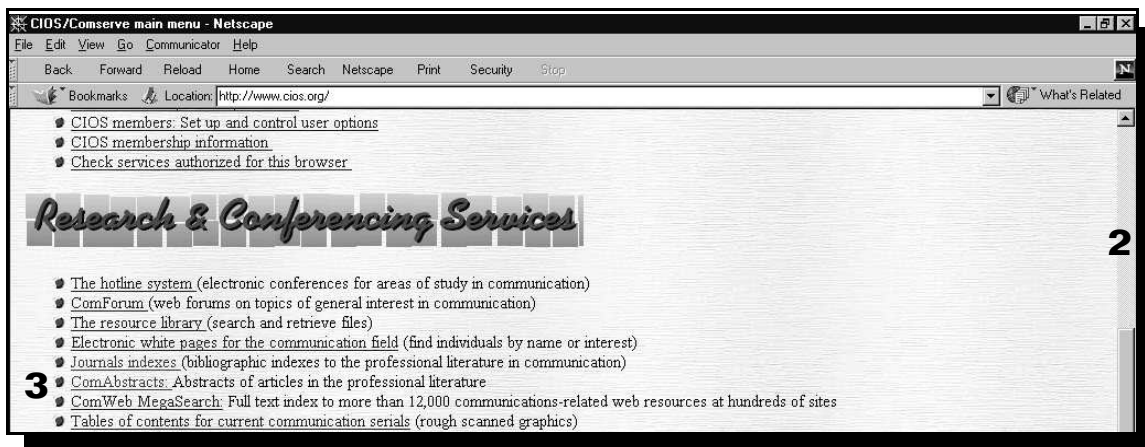


### Access Path

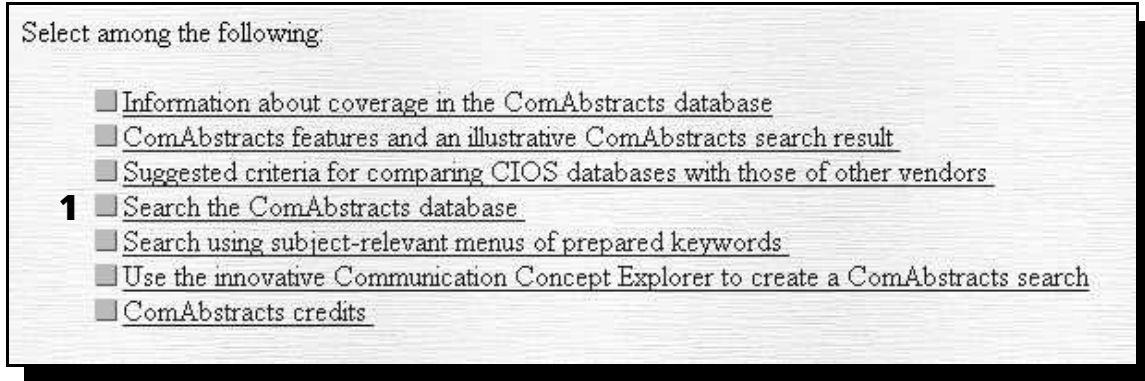
### 2. Scroll down to find ComAbstracts

## 1. Click Search the ComAbstracts database

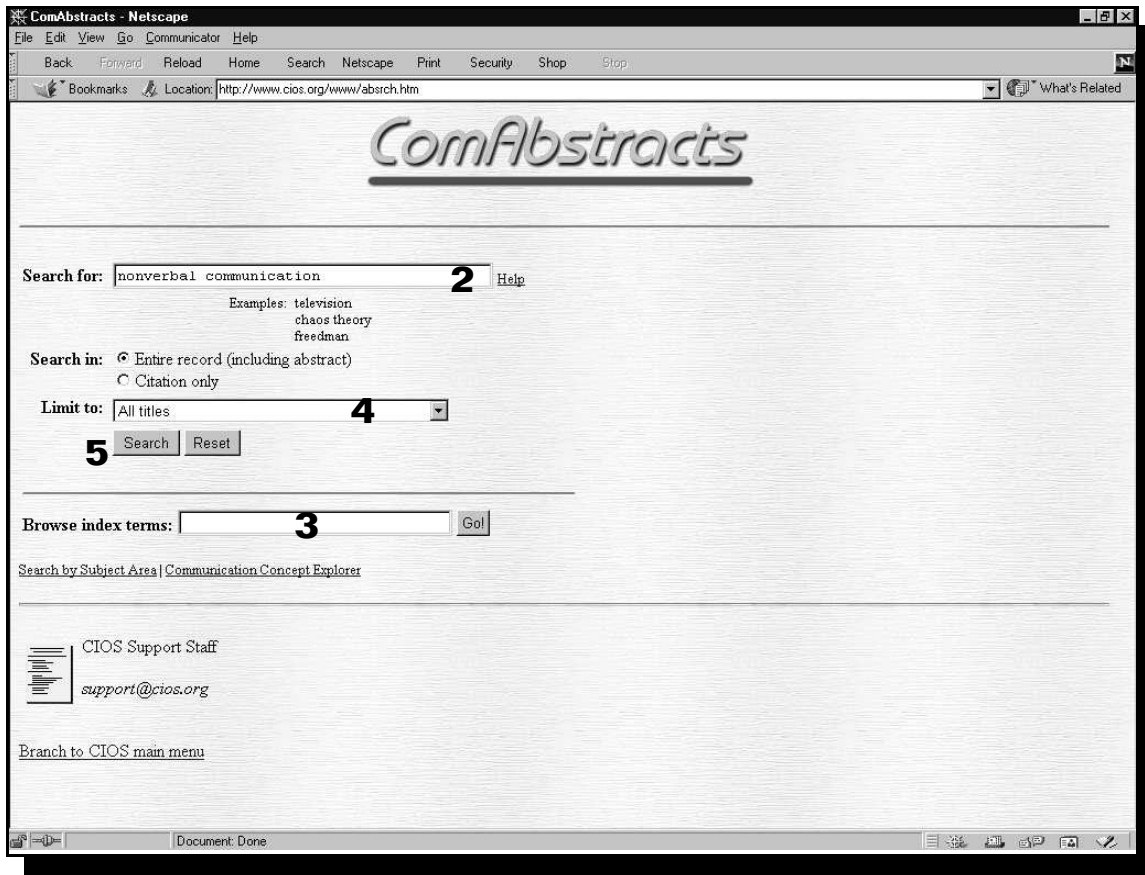


## 2. Enter search term(s) (click Help for keyword searching tips) OR

# Obtaining Information

1. Click **Author contact info** or **Author background** to learn more about the author
2. Click **Search result: Page 1** to return to result list
3. Use **Next document** and **Previous document** to view other records
4. To print use the Netscape commands:  
Click **File**, then **Print Preview** to view your document, click **Print**, choose the number of pages you wish to print, then click **OK**
5. To download use the Netscape commands:  
Click **File**, then **Save as**, change File Type to **plain text** if necessary, change File Name to **a:name of file**, then click **Save**
