Getting Started

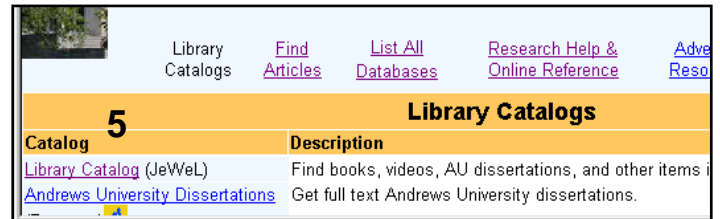
1. Select type of search.
 2. Enter search terms.
 3. Click **Search**.
- OR for more search options:**
4. Click **Library Catalogs**.
 5. Click **Library Catalog (JeWeL)**.

Find books, videos, and other items owned by the James White Library.

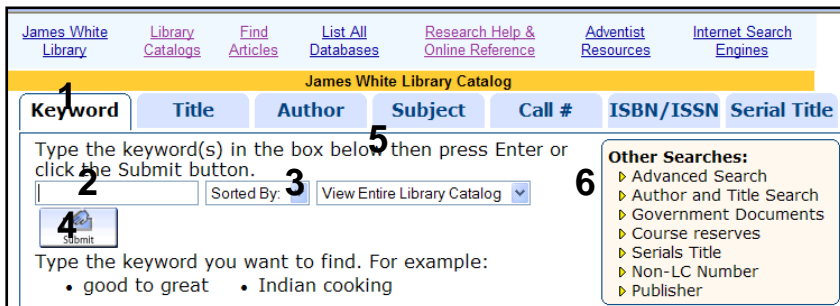
Access Path:

Searching

1. Click the **KEYWORD** tab.
2. Enter your search terms. Surround terms with quotes to search for a phrase.
3. To choose how you want the records sorted, click **Sort By**
4. Click **Submit**.
5. To search for an author, title, or subject, etc. follow the above procedure, after clicking on the appropriate tab.
6. For a more detailed search, choose **Advanced Search**.



Advanced Search

1. With **Advanced Search** you can use multiple search terms
2. You can also limit by location or material type.
3. Results can be restricted to a certain language or range of publication dates.

Reading the Results

1. Check the number of results.
2. Click on a title to view the catalog record.
3. Click **Start Over** to do a new search.
4. Click **Another Search** to do another advanced keyword search.
5. Use **Modify Search** to refine your results by language, date, format, or location.
6. To download or email records, click in the boxes, then click **Save Marked Records**.
7. To do a similar search in the Michigan Electronic Catalog, click **Search Me!Cat**.

Viewing a Record

1. Note the basic bibliographic information for the item.
2. Many book records have a contents note or link.
3. Click on a subject heading to find more items on this subject.
4. Note the **Location**, **Call No.** and **Availability**.

Subject Tracing

Subject tracing is a two-step search method. First, do a keyword search. Examine the results for relevant subject headings. Then click on the selected subject headings.
