About the Presenters



Jiri Moskala, BA, M.Th., Th.D., Ph.D. is Professor of Old Testament exegesis and theology at the Seventh-day Adventist Theological Seminary at Andrews University. He joined the faculty in 1999. Prior to coming to Andrews, Moskala served in various capacities (ordained pastor, administrator, teacher, and principal) in the Czech Republic. He is a member of different theological societies and has authored or edited a number of articles and books in the Czech and English languages. In addition, he has participated in several archaeological expeditions in Tell Jalul, Jordan.



Dwight K. Nelson, M.Div., DMin., has been senior pastor of Pioneer Memorial Church of Seventh-day Adventists on the campus of Andrews University since 1983. He also serves as adjunct professor for homiletics at the Seventh-day Adventist Theological Seminary. He is the author of *The Claim, Built to Last, Outrageous Grace, Countdown to Showdown, The Jesus Generation, A New Way to Pray*, and *The God-Forsaken God*.



James R. Nix, M.Div., MLS, is director of the Ellen G. White Estate at the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists. He is author of numerous articles and several books, including *The Spirit of Sacrifice and Commitment* and *Early Advent Singing*.



Gluder Quispe, M.Div., M.Th., is currently a Ph.D. candidate in Adventist Studies with a cognate in New Testament at the Seventh-day Adventist Theological Seminary at Andrews University. For eight years he was senior pastor in the Lake Titicaca Conference in Peru and has served as an administrator and professor at the Peruvian Union University. He is the author of three books: *Camino se hace al andar, Retos en acción*, and *Grandes temas de la Biblia*. His dissertation title is "The Apocalypse in the Seventh-day Adventist Church: Three Approaches."



Ranko Stefanovic, Ph.D., is Professor of New Testament at the Seventh-day Adventist Theological Seminary at Andrews University. Prior to joining the faculty at Andrews University, he served for eighteen years as an ordained SDA minister in his home country of what used to be Yugoslavia. He chaired the Department of Religious Studies at Canadian University College, from 1996-1999. He is author of *Revelation of Jesus Christ*, a 670-page commentary on the book of Revelation which is the standard textbook in many Adventist colleges and universities.

All presentations are in the Seventh-day Adventist Theological Seminary Chapel located at Andrews University.
