Scope and Content

William Henry Branson (1887-1961) served the Seventh-Day Adventist Church as evangelist, conference president, division president in Africa (1920-1930), China (1946-1950), and president of the General Conference (1950-1954).

This collection contains six binders of W. H. Branson's sermon outlines on various topics including church organization, evangelistic series, the exposition of the Bible, and many other topics. These are likely the notes he took to the pulpit when he preached. There are also materials for sermon preparation, such as illustrations from newspapers, quotations from the writings of Ellen G. White and other authors.

Arrangement

The binders are arranged based on limited chronological information in the binder itself. The binders are as Branson left them. The contents within each binder are generally alphabetical with the same topic appearing in more than one binder.

Provenance

Ronald L. Numbers donated this collection to the Andrews University Center for Adventist Research in 1983. Numbers is a nephew of W. H. Branson.
