1. An Andrews University User Name and Password or an Andrews University Email Account Name and Password

2. Internet access and an email address

- < A connection to the Internet via an Internet Service Provider (ISP), and
- < An email account from Andrews University, your Internet Service Provider, or an Internet email service such as Hotmail, Yahoo, etc. Andrews email account is preferred.

3. Adequate computer hardware and software
