APA Style Guide Adopted for DMin Project Reports/Dissertations

Due to the practical nature of the Doctor of Ministry projects, after much discussion and consideration, the program administrators have determined that the project writing process would be better served by transitioning to the use of the American Psychological Association style guide. While this change is to be implemented now, participants who have already completed the DMin Project Proposal course but have not yet begun writing the project may choose whether to proceed with APA or continue with the Turabian Manual.
