- A new concentration is offered especially for [church organizational leaders](#) such as presidents, vice-presidents for administration, departmental directors and coordinators. Doctoral projects will require a current ministry context in such areas of responsibility.
- The [Discipleship and Biblical Spirituality](#) concentration launches a new cohort in February 2014; application deadline is **November 29, 2013**.
- The [Youth and Young Adult Ministry](#) concentration will form a new cohort to start in February of 2014; application deadline is **November 29, 2013**.
- A new concentration for chaplains with dual-track intensives is scheduled March 31 – April 15, 2014 (application deadline **January 31, 2014**). Chaplains specializing in health care will have a separate-but-concurrent track in the first and fourth years of their program. Important Note for Current Program Participants

Registrations are being prepared now for the fall semester. DMin participants are registered by University staff—you do not register yourself online. To ensure there is no delay in getting your registration entered, be sure you have financial clearance. If you need to make any special arrangements, or to confirm whether you are cleared, contact Vicki Thomson, Associate Director of Student Financial Services: vlt@andrews.edu, 1-269-471-6995.

Remember, failure to register will bring about the loss of student loan deferment, and could jeopardize your status to remain in the program. **Registration is not optional—it is required for every semester you are in the program**; either for credits in the semesters you have intensives, or for continuation in all other semesters (summers included!). There is a charge for continuation in the semesters following your fourth year's module; currently the charge is \$600 per semester.
