Recent Project Assessments





What is the "Learning Hub?"



It is a tool that may allow you to access course documents, submit assignments, and view grades. A Learning Hub quick reference guide is provided on the Andrews website.

Important Reminder of the Policy for Petitioning a Program Extension

Occasionally, unforeseen circumstances prevent a participant from being quite ready for project assessment by the time the end of the six-year program limit is in sight. Persons who wish to petition a one-year program extension should apply no later than the beginning of the final semester within their six-year limit; the window of opportunity to apply will close thirty days into that semester. Remember, a significant fee applies!

New Tuition Rates Start in August

The new academic year begins in late August and with it comes new tuition rates for the University. Here is how it will affect DMin participants:

DMin tuition for one year (8 credits) after subsidy reduction:	3,514.00
Per-semester continuation fee in yrs 4 and 5:	700.00
Per-semester fee for program extension (beyond 6 th yr)	1,156.00
