Introducing the new program director



Effective with the new year, Dr. Kleber Gonçalves took up responsibilities as the director of the Doctor of Ministry program. No stranger to Andrews, Dr. Gonçalves resided in the Andrews community while engaged in Master level studies (MDiv Equiv.; MSA Church Administration) and later while achieving a PhD in Missiology (2005). His doctoral studies focused on urban mission and postmodernism.

Prior to accepting the call to Andrews, Kleber worked in the São Paulo Conference in Brazil, where he started the New Seed SDA Church, a church-planting project focusing on secular/postmodern people.

In addition to his new roles as Associate Professor of World Mission and DMin Program Director, he also serves as the director of the Center for Secular and Postmodern Studies (CSPS), Office of Adventist Mission, at the General Conference.

Program time limit reminder
