Dear DMin Family,

I am here to share with you the latest changes in the Doctor of Ministry Program, so I wish to notify you of the new Program Director appointment:

Dr. Hyveth Williams, professor of Homiletics, will become the DMin Director beginning February 10, 2020.



Dr. Hyveth Williams served for thirteen-and-a-half years as senior pastor of Campus Hill Church in Loma Linda, California. She is the first black female pastor and the first female senior pastor in the Seventh-day Adventist denomination. Prior to her appointment as professor in 2009, she also served as an adjunct professor of religion on the Loma Linda University Faculty of Religion and Andrews University Theological Seminary. A graduate of Columbia Union College with a Bachelor of Arts in Theology (1984), Pastor Williams received her Master of Divinity degree from Andrews University Theological Seminary (1989). In 1998 she graduated from Boston University School of Theology with a Doctor of Ministry degree. Dr. Williams holds the distinction of being the first non-Episcopalian to receive the prestigious Fellowship from the Episcopal College of Preachers, National Cathedral, Washington, D.C.

## Changes and Transitions

Dr. Kleber Gonçalves has accepted a full-time position at the General Conference as Director of the Global Mission Center for Secular and Postmodern Studies, Office of Adventist Mission, beginning January 1, 2020. He will not move physically to Washington, DC, as he can lead this important work from here and be involved in the worldwide church.

Dr. Kleber has been the Director of the DMin program since January 1, 2016. Even though working at the General Conference, Dr. Kleber will still closely collaborate with us, leading several DMin cohorts to their graduation as well as supervising several new initiatives related to mission.

Thank you, Kleber, for your commitment to the Seminary, your energetic leadership of the DMin program, and continued support.

The 2020 Chaplaincy cohort will have two paths to choose from:

1. Chaplaincy

**Admission Requirements:** Normal DMin admission process.

2. Dual Chaplaincy and ACPE Certified Educator Process

**Admission Requirements:** Applicant must be associated with an ACPE Center, with a Training Educator and be accepted into the Certified Educator process of ACPE, Inc. Applicant may be from any faith tradition. After admission to the ACPE process applicants can then be accepted in the DMin program through the normal admission process. Applicants may not have been in the Certified Educator process of ACPE, Inc. for more than 12 months.
