- El informe de lectura y la monografía deberán entregarse el primer día de clase-**Septiembre 7, 2008.**
- Trabajos que se entregan tarde serán penalizados con **6 puntos.**

Requisitos posteriores al intensivo

- Este requisito cuenta por **40 puntos** del puntaje total.
