TAP THE POTENTIAL

Investing in the discipleship of students and enhancing their Christian impact on their campus and community is at the core of the Graduate Certificate in Campus Spiritual Leadership. Students face enormous challenges in contemporary culture. Campus life affords opportunities to influence and to be influenced. The Graduate Certificate in Campus Spiritual Leadership equips you for the challenges and empowers you to be a significant Christian influence on young lives.

DESCRIPTION

The Graduate Certificate in Campus Spiritual Leadership has two tracks for training leaders in campus ministry: Christian campus track and public campus track.

The certificate consists of 12 semester credits distributed in six courses. Each summer two courses are offered in July. All courses are one-week intensives requiring pre-campus work and post-campus field application. The two courses are scheduled back to back, requiring only two weeks of residence on campus each summer. The entire program can be completed in three summers. The instructors are academics and practitioners in the areas of campus ministry and young adult discipleship.

Christian Campus Track is designed for professionals with responsibility for some aspect of the spiritual growth of students on Christian academy or college campuses. Typical applicants would be campus pastors, chaplains, Bible teachers, principals, residence hall deans, and student services directors.

Public Campus Track is designed for those who want to minister to Seventh-day Adventist students and others attending public universities. Typical applicants would be pastors, youth pastors, and lay leaders of youth and young adult ministries in local congregations near public universities. Either track would be appropriate for conference and union youth and education directors.

COSTS OF THE PROGRAM

Costs for the program are based on a per credit rate. For the summer of 2007, the cost is \$700 per credit. Books for each summer's courses range from \$100–\$200. A non-credit option is available. The non-credit fee is \$200 per course.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Admission to the Graduate Certificate Program in Campus Spiritual Leadership has the same requirements as admission into an Andrews University master's degree program, except a GRE score is not needed. Application documents needed: completed Application for Graduate Admission form; statement of purpose; recommendations from two professionals; bachelor's degree or its equivalent; official transcripts.

USA residents who are entering the certificate program may enroll in courses the first summer on PTC basis (permission to take classes). All international students must be officially admitted into the program in order to obtain the necessary I-20 form.
