Art Competition Rules

The Andrews University Counseling and Testing Center (CTC) is inviting students to participate in an art competition to celebrate the National Eating Disorder Awareness Week (February 24 – March 4, 2013). The selected works of art will be exhibited at Campus Center on Thursday, February 28, 2013, from 12pm-3pm.

Theme:

“Celebrating Every Body”

Goal:

To promote a healthy body image and raise awareness about eating disorders in our community.

Eligibility

All entries must be original works of art created at any time by current Andrews University students.

Rules of Entry

- There is no entry fee.
- Student can only submit one work of art.
- Two-dimensional work in all media, including, but not limited to: Drawing, painting, photography, collage, and computer-generated imagery.
- Size is limited to 36 inches any direction (including frame, if any)
- The selected works of art will be displayed at the Campus Center on Thursday February 28, 2013, from 12pm-3pm during an Awareness Event sponsored by the Counseling & Testing.
- The top three works of art will continue to be exhibited in the CTC's showcase until end of semester (Bell Hall).
- Winners will be announced on Thursday February 28, 2013 at Chapel.
- All completed works of art must be delivered to the Counseling & Testing Center by Monday, February 25, 2013 at 5pm along with a completed application form.

- All works of art will be available for pick up at the end of the exhibition on Thursday, February 28, 2013 at the Campus Center. Exhibited work will be available for pick up Friday May 28, 2013, after the Awareness Event.
- All works of art must be picked up by Friday, May 03, 2013 at 12pm. The CTC will take no responsibility for works left after that time and will consider the work to have been abandoned. Such work will become the property of the CTC to be used as it deems appropriate.
- The CTC is not responsible for lost, stolen or misdirected entries.
- Your entry acknowledges acceptance of these rules.

Prizes

A panel of counselors and professors will select the three works of art that best represent the theme for our exhibit: "Celebrating Every Body." The panel will also consider original concept, expressive use of media, and artistic excellence. The selected works of art will be awarded the following prizes:
