Webconferencing Available

Starting March 1, the DLiT has available 4 licenses for Adobe Acrobat Connect for Andrews University community to use. If you would like to have a license for your own area the cost is \$150 per year and you would need to make arrangements with the DLiT.

However, if you have webconferencing needs and do not want to purchase the license, you can “rent” a license for \$25.00 each use. Those arrangements must be made 2-3 days in advance.

The Student Opinion of Teaching Survey is available in an online format. To have your class participate contact your Dean's office.

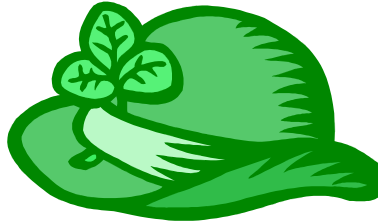
