Moving to Moodle

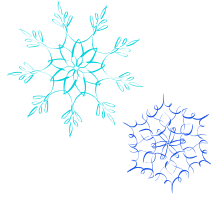
On November 29, 2010 the Andrews University faculty voted to move away from D2L to Moodle. As of January 10, 2011 the contract with Moodlerooms, a third party hosting facility was signed. What does this mean for you?

- We will continue with D2L through the Spring 2011 semester.
- Late February DLiT will have their annual technology fair in which we will “kick off” Moodle.
- Training will be available starting March 2011.
- Summer and Fall courses will be put in Moodle.
- DLiT will convert the D2L courses into Moodle.
