1. Every student is required to file an application for admission and have a letter of acceptance from the Admissions Office.
2. Registration begins by obtaining Financial Clearance. Please refer to the Financial Information section of the University Bulletin or by visiting Student Financial Services online.
3. Important Registration Dates for Summer Sessions 2012
  - Online Course Registration for Summer 2012 begins on March 26, 2012.
  - Counter Registration in the Administration Building for Summer 2012 opens March 26, 2012.
  - Changes without charge may be made through the third class day of each session, and the second day of class for May Express classes.
    - A charge of \$30.00 is made for each Drop/Add Form approved after these dates.
4. Important Academic Dates: The complete published Academic Calendar is available online.
  - May Express: Begin May 7. Check with department offering course for specific end date.
  - Summer Term 1: May 14-June 8 2012
  - Summer Term 2: June 11-July 6, 2012
  - Summer Term 3: July 9-August 3, 2012
5. SUMMER 2012 LATE FEES: Students registering for the first time after the open course registration dates are charged a late registration fee of \$75.00. Late Registration Fees are assigned on the second class day of the term for summer sessions.
6. The University reserves the right to cancel courses due to low class enrollment and to alter class schedules.
7. Careful course selection results in few if any registration changes. Advisors are available for counsel; nevertheless, students are responsible for knowing the requirements stated in the Bulletin. As previously stated, changes in registration after the deadline incur a charge of \$30.00.
8. Students should consult their Academic Bulletin for curriculum requirements. When a student's period of residence has been broken, his or her requirements for graduation may be subject to change.

### ADVISORS

Students are assigned academic advisors through the Student Success Center based on their chosen major. Advisors function as academic guidance counselors to help students schedule their courses, be aware of academic rules and regulations, and make decisions regarding their future. Although advisors assist students, the responsibility for meeting degree requirements and knowing the rules which govern academic policies always rests with the individual student. Please visit the Office of Student Success in Nethery Hall Suite 100 for questions about tutoring and academic advising.

### ATTENDANCE REGULATIONS

1. Regular attendance at all classes, laboratories, and other academic appointments is required of all students. Whenever the number of absences exceeds 20 percent (10 percent for graduate classes) of the total course appointments, the teacher may give a failing grade.
2. Merely being absent from campus does not exempt students from this policy.
3. Absences recorded because of late registration, suspension, and early/late vacation leaves are not excused.
4. Class work missed may be made up only if the teacher allows.
5. Three tardies are equal to one absence.
6. The instructor applies the above regulations and determines the final grade.

### PAYMENT PLAN

Tuition and applicable residence hall charges are due and payable in full at the time of registration. Any exceptions to the above plan must be approved by Student Financial Services prior to registration. Accounts for conference or institutionally sponsored students are billed directly to the supporting organization only if such arrangement has been authorized in writing prior to registration.

### DINING SERVICES

During the Summer terms, students may participate in a declining-balance Meal Plan. Meal Plans may be purchased at Registration Central or at the Dining Services. Students may use such an account for making food purchases at the Dining Center, Cardinal's Nest, and the Gazebo by presenting their ID Card to the cashier. Menu items are individually priced and students are charged for only those items chosen. For those who so desire, a Summer Meal Plan is also available.

### MEALS FOR FAMILIES

Food service is available during each Summer term at the Dining Center located on the second floor of the Campus Center. Pricing is a la carte. Debit cards are available at the Food Service Office. A debit card may be purchased in various dollar values and used at the Dining Center in place of carrying cash.

## STUDENT EMPLOYMENT

The Immigration Reform and Control Act charges all employers to examine and verify documents that establish employment eligibility of all new employees. New and returning students who never completed an I-9 for Andrews University work in the past who plan to seek employment on the Andrews University campus must supply documents of identity and employability. Some documents serve both purposes, but if not available, two documents must be presented. All documents must be original. The following are required.

### **A. Documents that Establish both Identity and Employment Authorization:**

1. U.S. passport or U.S. Passport Card
2. Permanent Resident Card or Alien Registration Receipt Card (Form I-551)
3. Foreign passport that contains a temporary I-551 stamp or temporary I-551 printed notation on a machine-readable immigrant visa
4. Employment Authorization Document that contains a photograph (Form I-766)
5. In the case of a nonimmigrant alien authorized to work for a specific employer incident to status, a foreign passport with Form I-94 or Form I-94A bearing the same name as the passport and containing an endorsement of the alien's nonimmigrant status, as long as the period of endorsement has not yet expired and the proposed employment is not in conflict with any restrictions or limitations identified on the form
6. Passport from the Federated States of Micronesia (FSM) or the Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI) with Form I-94 or Form I-94A indicating nonimmigrant admission under the Compact of Free Association Between the United States and the FSM or RMI

1. Driver's license or ID card issued by a state or outlying possession of the United States provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, gender, height, eye color, and address
2. ID card issued by federal, state or local government agencies of entities, provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, gender, height, eye color and address
3. School ID card with a photograph
