- I Agree 1. I will be part of a **faith-based institution** by respecting Andrews University's Seventh-day Adventist Christian perspective and values.
- I Agree 2. I will adopt a **wholesome lifestyle** guided by the core values of the Andrews University community.
- Honesty: We refrain from lying, cheating, and stealing.
 - Modesty: We exhibit modesty and simplicity in behavior and dress.
 - Sexual Purity: We refrain from engaging in pre-marital sex, adultery, and pornography.
 - Respect for Others: We do not tolerate any form of verbal, physical, or sexual abuse.
 - Healthful Living: We abstain from using alcohol, tobacco, and illegal drugs.
 - Safety: We do not tolerate the possession or use on or off campus of firearms, explosive devices, or other prohibited weapons.
- I Agree 3. I will live on a **residential campus** in a University residence hall while under the age of 22 and participate in a meal plan at the University's vegetarian cafeteria (unless living in the community with my parents).
- I Agree 4. I will be part of a **gathered community** by attending required weekly chapels and other co-curricular programs.
