International Students

- Balanced Estimated Budget Sheet
- Notarized affidavit of support for all personal funds and/or sponsorships
- Twelve-months worth of bank documentation
- \$2,000 advance deposit

Canadian Students

- Balanced Estimated Budget Sheet
- Notarized affidavit of support for all personal funds and/or sponsorships
- Twelve-months worth of bank documentation

PAYMENT PLANS

- Tuition Guarantee Plan—Undergraduate Student Cash Plan.** Pay in cash the full estimated charges for the year (tuition, room, board, books, insurance and fees) on or before each fall semester registration to lock the tuition rate.
- Cash Discount Plan.** Pay total yearly estimated charges (tuition, room, board, books, insurance and fees) on or before fall semester registration and receive a 5% discount on expenses not covered by financial aid. Pay total semester's estimated charges (tuition, room, board, books, insurance and fees) on or before each semester's registration and receive a 2% discount on expenses not covered by financial aid.
- Installment Plan.** Arrange installment payments for estimated 'out-of-pocket' expenses for the semester on or before each semester's registration.
