AUGUST 12-13, 2015 | 10 PM-DAWN

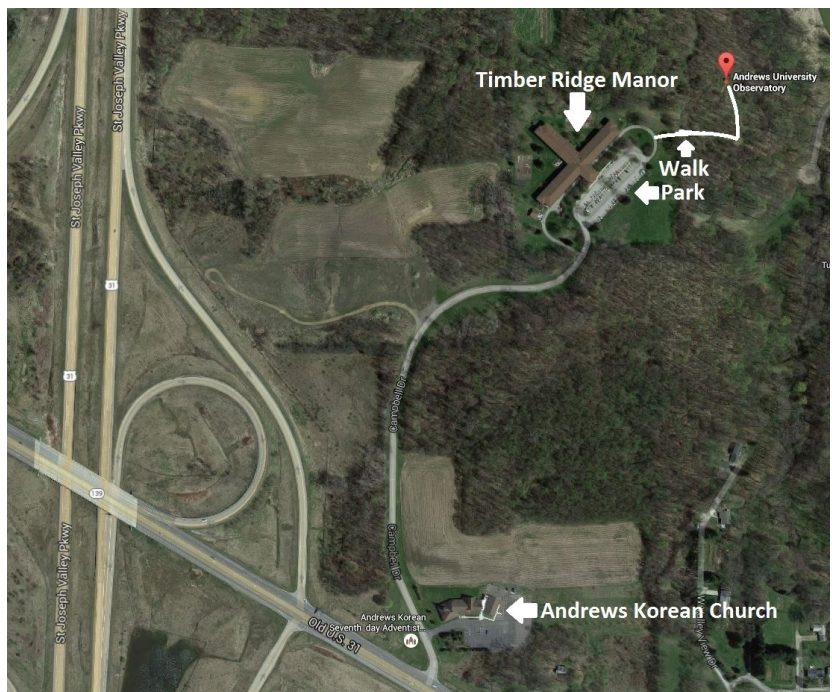
ANDREWS UNIVERSITY OBSERVATORY | BERRIEN SPRINGS, MI

- For your viewing comfort, bring chairs and blankets. Nighttime temperatures may be cooler than you think, and you'll appreciate having the extra insulation.
- The observatory will also be open for stargazing. **Saturn** is best viewed before 11 pm.

Uranus and **Neptune** will be visible later in the night.

- Come for part or all of the night.

- **Everyone is welcome.**
- **Meteors** should be visible throughout the night and are expected to be at their highest frequency after 2 am.
- You may see up to **sixty meteors per hour** at the peak.
- If weather doesn't permit, cancellation will be announced via twitter.com/auastrowatch.
