- For your viewing comfort, bring chairs and blankets. Nighttime temperatures may be cooler than you think, and you'll appreciate having the extra insulation.
- The observatory will also be open for stargazing. **Saturn** is best viewed before 11 pm.
- **Uranus** and **Neptune** will be visible later in the night.
- Come for part or all of the night.
- Everyone is welcome.
- Meteors should be visible throughout the night and are expected to be at their highest frequency after 2 am.
- You may see up to sixty meteors per hour at the peak.
- If weather doesn't permit, cancellation will be announced via twitter.com/ auastrowatch.
