OBJECTIVE

To increase spiritual atmosphere in Hong Kong Adventist College (HKAC) campus and prepare missionary for Asian countries.

- Building up personal network in Asia.
- Gain great working experience in the Asian culture.
- Taking courses related to the Chinese culture.
- Free tuition. (up to 8 credits per semester from Andrews University)
