Medicare

Medicare is a Federal health insurance program for people 65 years or older, certain people with disabilities, and people with end-stage renal disease (ESRD). When you first enroll in Medicare, you'll have Original Medicare, unless you another There choice. are different ways you can get Medicare coverage, including a Medicare Advantage Plan (like HMO or PPO). In some types of plans that don't offer drug coverage, you may be able to join a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan.

Get detailed information about the Medicare health and prescription drug plans in your area, including what they cost and what services they provide.

- Find doctors or other health care providers and suppliers who participate in Medicare.
- See what Medicare covers, including preventive services.
- Get Medicare appeals information and forms.
- Get information about the quality of care provided by plans, nursing homes, hospitals, home health agencies, and dialysis facilities.
- Look up helpful websites and phone numbers.

Medicaid

Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP)

partnership CHIP is а between the federal and state governments that provides lowhealth coverage cost children in families that earn too much money to qualify for Medicaid. In some states, CHIP covers pregnant women. Each state offers CHIP coverage, and works closely with its state Medicaid program. CHIP benefits are different in each state. But provide states comprehensive coverage, like routine check-ups, immunizations, doctor visits, and prescriptions.

Each state program has its own rules about who qualifies for Medicaid and CHIP. You can apply right now, any time of year, and find out if you qualify. If you apply for Medicaid coverage to your state agency, you'll also find out if your children qualify for CHIP. You must check with the CHIP office in the state you live in to confirm if your family is eligible to get benefits. Health Insurance Marketplace

Health The Insurance Marketplace was created by the Affordable Care Act and helps you find health coverage that fits your needs and budget. Every health plan in Marketplace offers the same set of essential health benefits, including doctor visits, preventive care, hospitalization, prescriptions, and more. You can compare plans based on price, benefits, quality, and other features important to you before you make a choice. People in most states use HealthCare.gov to apply for and enroll in health coverage.

FAQ²

Q: What is Medicare Part A?

Medicare Part A helps cover your inpatient care in hospitals, critical access hospitals, and skilled nursing facilities (not custodial or long-term care). It also helps cover hospice care and some home health care. You must meet certain conditions to get these benefits.

Cost: Most people don't have to pay a monthly payment, called a premium, for Part A. This is because they or a spouse paid Medicare taxes while they were working. If you (or your spouse) didn't pay Medicare taxes while you worked and you are age 65 or older, you may be able to buy Part A.

If you aren't sure if you have Part A, look on your red, white, and blue Medicare card. If you have Part A, "Hospital (Part A)" is printed on your card. You can call Social Security at 1-800-772-1213, or visit your local Social Security office for more information about buying Part A. If you get benefits from the Railroad Retirement Board (RRB), call your local RRB office or 1-800-808-0772.

Q: What is Medicare Part B?

A: Medicare Part B helps cover medical services like doctors' services, outpatient care, and other medical services that Part A doesn't cover. Part B is optional. Part B helps pay for covered medical services and items when they are medically necessary. Part B also covers some preventive services like exams, lab tests, and screening shots to help prevent, find, or manage a medical problem.

Cost: If you have Part B, you pay a Part B premium each month. Most people will pay the standard premium amount. If you don't sign up for Part B when you are first eligible, you may have to pay a late enrollment penalty.

Q: What does Part B of Medicare (Medical Insurance) cover?

Q: What is Medicare Part C?

A: A Medicare Advantage Plan (like an HMO or PPO) is another Medicare health plan choice you may have as part of Medicare. Medicare Advantage Plans, sometimes called "Part C" or "MA Plans," are offered by private companies approved by Medicare.

If you join a Medicare Advantage Plan, the plan will provide all of your Part A (Hospital Insurance) and Part B (Medical Insurance) coverage. Medicare Advantage Plans may offer extra coverage, such as vision, hearing, dental, and/or health and wellness programs. Most include Medicare prescription drug coverage (Part D).

Medicare pays a fixed amount for your care every month to the companies offering Medicare Advantage Plans. These companies must follow rules set by Medicare. However, each Medicare Advantage Plan can charge different out-of-pocket costs and have different rules for how you get services (like whether you need a referral to see a specialist or if you have to go to only doctors, facilities, or suppliers that belong to the plan for non-emergency or non-urgent care). These rules can change each year.

Q: What is Medicare Part D?

A: Medicare Part D is Prescription Drug Coverage. Since January 1, 2006, everyone with Medicare, regardless of income, health status, or prescription drug usage has had access to prescription drug coverage.

Q: Who is eligible for Medicare?

Generally, Medicare is for people 65 or older. You may be able to get Medicare earlier if you have a disability, End-Stage Renal Disease (permanent kidney failure requiring dialysis or a transplant), or ALS (also called Lou Gehrig's disease).

Medicare has four parts:

- Part A (Hospital Insurance)
- Part B (Medicare Insurance)
- Part C (Medicare Advantage Plans
- Part D (Drug Coverage)

Part A premium

Most people don't pay a premium for Part A coverage. This is sometimes called "premium-free Part A." You won't pay a Part A premium if you:

- Qualify to get (or are already getting) retirement or disability benefits from Social Security (or the Railroad Retirement Board).
- Get Medicare earlier than 65.
- Are 65 or older and you (or another qualifying person, like your current or former spouse) paid Medicare taxes while working for a certain amount of time (usually at least 10 years).

If you don't qualify for premium-free Part A, you might be able to buy it.

Part B premium

You'll pay a premium for Part B coverage every month, even if you don't get any Part B-covered services. The monthly premium can change each year and may be higher depending on your income. Most people don't get a bill from Medicare because they get the premium deducted automatically from their Social Security, Railroad Retirement Board, or Civil Service Retirement check. If you don't get any of these payments, you'll get a bill for your Part B premium so you can pay Medicare directly.

Part C premium

Monthly premiums for Part C coverage vary based on which plan you join. The premium amount can change each year.

Part D premium

Monthly premiums for Part D coverage vary based on which plan you join. The premium amount can change each year. You may also have to pay an extra amount each month based on your income.

Q: When should I sign up for Medicare?

A: Generally, people is advised to sign up for Medicare when they're first eligible to avoid a gap in coverage and/or late enrollment penalties. For most people, Medicare eligibility starts three months before turning 65 and ends three months after turning 65. If you're already getting Social Security benefits, you'll be automatically enrolled in Medicare Part A and Part B (you don't need to apply). However, because you must pay a premium for Part B coverage, you have the option of turning it down. You'll get your Medicare card about three months before you turn 65. (Note: Residents of Puerto Rico or foreign countries won't get Part B automatically. They must sign up for this benefit.)

If you don't get Medicare automatically, here are some ways to sign up*:

Online (at Social Security), links to an external website - You'll need to create your secure my Social Security account to sign up for Medicare or apply for benefits.

Call Social Security at 1-800-772-1213. TTY users can call 1-800-325-0778.

Contact your local Social Security office.

If you or your spouse worked for a railroad, call the Railroad Retirement Board at 1-877-772-5772.

*When you sign up for Medicare, you can also apply for Social Security benefits at the same time if you want.

Note: If you don't sign up for Medicare when you're first eligible, you'll have to wait until the General Enrollment Period (January 1-March 31 each year) to sign up, and you may have to pay a late enrollment penalty.

Q: How do I enroll in Medicare?

Administration at 1-800-772-1213 to enroll in Medicare or to ask questions about whether you are eligible. You can also visit their web site at www.socialsecurity.gov.

The Medicare.gov Web site also has a tool to help you determine if you are eligibile for Medicare and when you can enroll. It is called the Medicare Eligibility Tool.

If you already receive benefits from Social Security:

If you already get benefits from Social Security or the Railroad Retirement Board, you are automatically entitled to Medicare Part A (Hospital Insurance) and Part B (Medical Insurance) starting the first day of the month you turn age 65. You will not need to do anything to enroll. Your Medicare card will be mailed to you about 3 months before your 65th birthday. If your 65th birthday is February 20, 2010, your Medicare effective date would be February 1, 2010. (Note: if your birthday is on the 1st day of any month, Medicare Part A and Part B will be effective the 1st day of the prior month. For example, if your 65th birthday is February 1, 2010, your Medicare effective date would be January 1, 2010.)

If you are not getting Social Security benefits:

If you are not getting Social Security benefits, you can apply for retirement benefits online at https://www.ssa.gov/medicare/sign-up. If you would like to file for Medicare only, you can apply by calling 1-800-772-1213

If you are under age 65 and disabled:

If you are under age 65 and disabled, and have been entitled to disability benefits under Social Security or the Railroad Retirement Board for 24 months, you will be automatically entitled to Medicare Part A and Part B beginning the 25th month of disability benefit entitlement. You will not need to do anything to enroll in Medicare. Your Medicare card will be mailed to you about 3 months before your Medicare entitlement date. (Note: If you are under age 65 and have Lou Gehrig's disease (ALS), you get your Medicare benefits the first month you get disability benefits from Social Security or the Railroad Retirement Board.) For more information about enrollment, call the Social Security Administration at 1-800-772-1213 or visit the Social Security web site.

Q: Who is eligible for Medicaid?

You may qualify for free or low-cost health care through Medicaid based on your income and family size. Eligibility rules differ among states. In all states, Medicaid gives health coverage to some individuals and families, including children, parents, people who are pregnant, elderly people with certain incomes, and people with disabilities. Some states have expanded their Medicaid programs to cover other adults below a certain income level.

There are two ways you can apply for Medicaid: Directly with your state.

Through the Health Insurance Marketplace®.

- Visit HealthCare.gov to create a Marketplace account and complete an application.
- Reply "yes" when asked if you'd like to see if you can get help paying for coverage.
- If the information on your application shows that someone in your household might qualify for Medicaid, the Marketplace will forward your application to your state for a final eligibility decision.
- You can also call the Marketplace Call Center at 1-800-318-2596 to apply. TTY users can call 1-855-889-4325.

Q: Where can I find a doctor that accepts Medicare and Medicaid?

A: Find a Medicare doctor

To find a provider that accepts Medicare payments, use the Care Compare tool, opens in a new tab on Medicare.gov. This tool gives you a list of professionals or group practices in the specialty and geographic area you specify, along with detailed profiles, maps and driving directions.

If you have trouble accessing the website or the search tool, please call 1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227) and a representative will be able to help you. TTY users can call 1-877-486-2048.

Find a Medicaid doctor

Medicaid programs vary by state and each state Medicaid agency maintains their own list of professionals that accept Medicaid. For further assistance, please contact your health plan or your state's Medicaid agency. For more information about Medicaid, visit the Medicaid & CHIP page, opens in a new tab on Healthcare.gov.

There are other directories on MedlinePlus that will help you find health professionals, services, and facilities, some of which may accept Medicare or Medicaid payments.
