THESIS ADVISOR AGREEMENT

The thesis is the culmination of the MS in Biology program, and a major investment of time and effort on the part of the master's student. Hence the choice of a thesis advisor is an important step toward completing the thesis and the program, and plays an important role in the development of the student's career goals and research interests.

A thesis advisor should be chosen by the end of a student's first fall semester. During the following spring semester, the student begins to work with his/her thesis advisor to form a thesis committee and to develop a thesis proposal, which is presented and defended immediately following this spring semester. The summer and academic year following is occupied largely with thesis research.
