Tips for Transfer Students to Make a Smooth Transition into Their Math Journey at Andrews

- 1) Check on iVue to see if you have a Mathematics Placement Exam score.
- 2) While you are on iVue, check that your credit for any transfer math courses (College Algebra or higher) is showing. If not, then follow up with Enrollment until these credits show.
- 3) If you don't have a Mathematics Placement Exam score and you don't have college credit for calculus, precalculus, trigonometry, or college algebra, then you need placement. You have the opportunity to prepare now for the mathematics placement with the ALEKS PPL package. Using this product, you can know where you will place and have access to a learning module to use for improving your placement.
- 4) Check in the <u>bulletin</u> and/or with your academic advisor to see what mathematics courses are required for your major and for the Andrews Core Experience (check the prerequisites of any science courses that are required also). If your current placement does not meet the prerequisites that you need for a course, but you believe you qualify, then you can use the <u>ALEKS PPL</u> package to review and improve your placement.
- 5) The placement and learning package gives you six months of access, so get started today to maximize your opportunity for optimal placement!
