• **Festival Concert** – the capstone event featuring the Festival Orchestra, Festival Chorale, Andrews University Singers, and select members of the Andrews University Symphony Orchestra. March 7, 4:00 p.m. (HPAC)

<u>Festival Choir</u>: If you wish to bring your select choir, the cutoff date to submit delegate names is this Friday January 17. After January 17, you will be limited to a maximum of 12 delegates. Participants must purchase their own choral music and bring it with them to the Festival.
