ITINERARY

Sun 01 Andrews University

Leave AU–ORD. Departure from PMC Parking Lot at 17:30. Arrive to Chicago at 19:30. Depart from Chicago by Turkish Airlines TK6 departing at 22:15.

TURKEY

Mon 02 Arrive to Istanbul-Constantinople at 17:00.

Tour guide will meet you after customs and baggage claim with an "ANDREWS UNIVERSITY" sign. Meet and transfer to the Grand Haliç Hotel for dinner. After dinner we will walk at Istiklal Caddesi and visit Galata Tower. Overnight at hotel. (D)

Tue 03 Istanbul

Visit the Hippodrome, SultanAhmet, Haggia Sophia, Lunch, Archeological Museum, Grand Bazaar, Bosphorus Boat Tour. Dinner at Grand Haliç Hotel. Free evening—organized walks (B,L,D).

Wed 04 Istanbul – Canakkale

Topkaki Palace & Harem, Justinian Underground Cistern, Drive to Çanakkale, Lunch on the way, Dinner at Tusan Hotel (B,L,D). <u>Evening classes</u>.

Thu 05 Canakkale – Troas – Assos – Pergamum – İzmir

Drive to Troas and visit new & old part, drive to Assos Athena Temple, lower-cemetery & walk down to Theater, Lunch, Drive to Pergamum, Acropolis. Drive to Izmir. Dinner at SC Inn Boutique Hotel. Free evening (B,L,D).

Fri 06 Izmir – Sardis – Philadelphia – Kuşadasi

Visit İzmir (Ruins, Church, Castle), Drive to Sardis. Sardis (Ruins, Gymnasium, Artemis Temple), Lunch, Drive to Philadelphia. Philadelphia Church. Drive to Kusadasi (beach time). Dinner and Beach Vesper at the Pine Bay Hotel (B,L,D).

Sat 07 Ephesus

Sabbath Worship, Ephesus Ruins and Terraces Houses, Virgin Mary Basilica, Lunch Boxes, Archeological Museum, Basilica St John, Artemis Temple. Dinner at hotel (B,L,D). Free evening—organized walks.

Sun 08 Kusadasi – Aphrodisias – Laodicea – Colossae – Pamukkale-Hierapolis

Drive Aphrodisias: City Ruins, Museum, Early Lunch, Drive to Laodicea—all city tour, Drive to Colossae. Climb city; Thermal Waters and Dinner at Colossae Thermal Hotel. (B,L,D)

Mon 09 Pamukkale – Konya (Iconium)

Necropolis entrance, walkthrough the necropolis, walk to Heriapolis Theater & James Chapel, walking down Travertine, Lunch Yalvaç, Drive to Antioch Psidia. Full city tour. Drive to Konya (Iconium). Dinner at Dedeman Hotel. Free evening—organized walks-shopping (B,L,D).

Tue 10 Konya – Cappadocia

Drive to Cappadocia. Ushicar Castle, Climb Castle, Walking down, Lunch, Agzikaharan Kavaranserail, Carpet Place, Goreme Air Open Museum-place of the Cappadocian Fathers, Shopping Pigeon Cliffs, Hotel Peri Tower, Dinner, Whirling Dervishes Show. (B,L,D).

Optional - Air Hot Ballon Ride. Kaymakli Underground City, Ceramic Avanos, Lunch, Shopping Pigeon Cliffs – Goreme, Optional Guided Horse excursion Goreme, Zelve Valley, Hiking/Trekking through Churches or Shopping or Turkish Bath (optional), Hotel. Dinner at Hotel (B,L,D). Evening classes.

Drive to Kayseri Airport at 06:45, Fly to Rome via Istanbul (<u>TK 2011 09:00/10:30</u> + <u>TK 1865</u> 12:40/14:20)

Visit Coliseum, Arches Titus & Constantine, Roman Forum, Mamartine Prison, Capitoline Hill & Circus Maximus, Michelangelo's Piazza del Campidoglio; Altare de la Patria & Piazza Venezia, Fontana de Trevi, Lunch, Arrive Vatican City, Vatican Museum - Sistine Chapel, Basilica St Peter, Dinner. Vespers at Hotel. Optional: Walk to Spanish Steps, Return to hotel (B,L,D).

Sat 14 Rome

Sabbath Worship - Rome SDA Church, Lunch Boxes, Basilica St John Outside the Wall/Basilica Papale San Paolo Fuori le Mura, San Clemente Basilica, Archbasilica St John Laterano & Santa Scala, Basilica St Pietro in Vincoli, (Optional) Santa Maria Maggiori, Dinner & Rest at the Hotel. Optional Evening Walk: Plaza Navona, Outside: Pantheon, Hadrian Temple, Fontana de Trevi; Return Hotel. (B,L,D).

Capitoline Museum, Campo di Fiori /Heretics Burned-Galileo's predecessor Giordano Bruno, Piazza Navona e Chiesa di Sant Agnese & Shopping, Pantheon, Lunch, Montecitori Palace, Piazza Colonna-Trajan, Spanish Steps, Piaza del Popolo & short visit to Two Churches Santa Maria Miracoli - Art, Drive to Firenze, Dinner - quick Pizza on the way, overnight Villa Aurora SDA. (B,L,D).

Mon 16 Firenze

Breakfast at Villa Aurora, Visit the Duomo (Tower, Baptistry), Grome Gelato, Leather Market & Wild Boar, Piazza della Republica, San Lorenzo, Market - Lunch, Piazza della Signoria - Fake David, Gallery Uffizi (walked by), Ponte Vecchio, Piazzale Michel Angelo, Dinner at Villa Aurora SDA. Free evening—Sport night with Italians+ACA students. (B,L,D).

Tue 17 Firenze – San Gimignano – Pisa – Turin.

Drive to San Gimignano, City tour, San Gimignano Museo della Tortura, Drive to Pisa, Lunch, Pisa outside-Piazza dei miracoli, Dinner at the Turin Hotel. <u>Evening classes</u>. (B,L,D).

Wed 18 Torino – Torre Pellice (Waldensians Valleys)
