Ten Fast Facts about Social Work

- 1. Social workers provide more mental health services (about 70%) than any other helping profession (yes, that includes psychologists and psychiatrists).
- 2. Social workers work with clients from birth (hospital social work) to death (hospice social work) and everywhere in between (schools, criminal justice, geriatrics, marriage & family counseling, etc.).
- 3. Social workers get so many jobs because they work on so many levels with individuals, families, groups, communities, as well as administration, politics and research.
- 4. Social workers help people with issues in their everyday lives, like relationship challenges, family difficulties, and drug and alcohol problems.
- 5. There are more than 640,000 social workers in the United States, with 13% growth projected through 2029.
- 6. Social workers focus more on strengths than pathologies it's more about who you can become, <u>not</u> how damaged your past has been.
- 7. Social work students have internships in real community agencies where would you like to work?
- 8. Although a bachelor's degree (BSW) is sufficient for entry into the field, an advanced degree (MSW) is the standard for many positions.
- 9. You can get an MSW degree in one extra year after completing your BSW degree. Keep your grades above 3.0!
