

Quick Facts Regarding Elementary Certification 2011-2012

Elementary Certification Requirements

- General Education courses - see attached sheet for specific GE requirements
- Choose either a subject major or 2 subject minors from list of approved majors/minors
- Planned Program minor
- Professional Education courses
- Maintain a 2.5 GPA in your major/minor, Planned Program minor and Professional Education courses. Courses with a grade of a C- or below in any of these areas will have to be repeated..

Requirements for Admission to the Teacher Preparation Program:

- Successful completion of the Michigan Basic Skills Test (MTTC Exam)
- Successful completion of EDTE165 Philosophical & Social Foundations of Educ.
- Have an overall GPA of 2.75 with no grade of a C- in major/minor or Professional Educ.
- Complete the application
 - Complete & submit all Forms
 - Michigan Testing Record
 - Portfolio Evaluation Form
 - Criminal Conviction Clearance Form (Misdemeanor & Felony Clearance)
 - 2 Recommendations (Instructor of EDTE165 and your advisor or professor)

Requirements for Admission to Student Teaching:

- Minimum GPA of 2.50 in major/minors, Planned Program minor and Professional Education courses with no grade of a C- or below
- Submit application for Student Teaching by **November 27** the year before you plan to do Student Teaching. In order to be accepted everything must be turned in.
- Student Teaching Application process includes:
 - Application
 - Michigan Testing Record Form
 - Portfolio Evaluation Form
 - Plan for Completing Degree Form
 - Criminal Conviction Clearance Form (Misdemeanor & Felony Clearance)
 - 3 Recommendations (2 education Professors and 1 content area Professor)

First Days of School Experience - August

- All DG's, I's, or a grades of a C-'s must be completed before beginning Student Teaching.
- Senior Exit Exam must be registered for and completed (undergraduates)
- MTTC Subject Area Exams and Elementary Exam must be successfully completed before you can begin Student Teaching
- Apply for Certification and submit necessary documents:
 - Official transcripts from any school attended other than Andrews University must be submitted to Jeannie Wolfer in the Department of Teaching, Learning, & Curriculum
 - Proof of First Aid and CPR Certification

Student Teaching Semester

- This is a FULL-TIME Experience so no additional courses may be taken during this semester except for Student Teaching Seminar (No additional job may be held during this time).
