The Michigan Department of Education is pleased to inform you Andrews University's significant amendment to prepare teachers of English (BA) has been granted initial approval. This program may be offered as a major or minor for secondary teaching certificates.

Andrews University is required to collect data related to the claims using key assessments for four years to determine the program efficacy. Any program changes or modifications based on annual data analysis initiated during initial approval must be reported to the Office of Professional Preparation Services. After four years, Andrews University must submit a letter requesting full approval, a report on fulfillment of the program claims, and any program changes or modifications made in response to analysis of key assessment data. This will be due **June 30**, **2019**, and must be submitted through <a href="mailto:educatorprograms@michiqan.qov">educatorprograms@michiqan.qov</a>.

The amendment also establishes a program efficacy plan with program claims and key assessments. The program is to be commended for an increased emphasis on the teaching of writing within the English major coursework.
