

CIEP ESL Program Tuition and Fees **2020-2021**

CIEP Fall & Spring Semesters

Students taking ESL classes in the Center for Intensive English Programs (CIEP) pay the following course fee:

12-16 credit hours/week \$5,040/semester
 Under 12 credit hours/week \$420/credit hour
 (Each course is 4 credit hours)

If taking non-credit ESL, individuals may register for a half semester, which is eight weeks in duration. If an individual registers for a half semester, it is highly recommended that the individual registers for the first eight weeks rather than the last eight weeks of the semester. The course fee for a half semester is \$2,527.50 for 12-16 non-credit hours.

In addition to tuition and course fees, general fees and food and housing costs will apply:

CIEP Summer Semester

Students taking ESL classes in the Center for Intensive English Programs (CIEP) pay the following course fee:

12-16 credit hours/week	\$5,040/semester
(may receive a discount)	
Under 12 credit hours/week	\$420/credit hour
(Each course is 4 credit hours)	

In addition to tuition and course fees, general fees and food and housing costs will apply: The **General Fee** for the Summer Semester is \$160. There is not a set **Food** plan in the summer, but please budget around \$8.00/breakfast, \$9.50/lunch, and \$9.50/dinner per day if you plan to eat in university dining facilities. For **Residence Hall** costs, the Summer 2021 Double Occupancy rate is \$ 23/night; the Single Occupancy rate is \$34-\$45/night. Please note that these housing rates many change in Summer 2022.

Transportation, Health Insurance, and Other Costs

Transportation will be provided to and from the South Bend Airport upon request made with reasonable notice. Students are responsible for transportation from other airports to Andrews University. Tuition and gee **do not** include textbooks, health insurance, and transportation to and from Andrews University. Health insurance is available through Andrews University for around \$150 per month for a single student. Participants in each program **must** show proof of insurance or purchase insurance at Andrews University.
