School of Nursing Admissions Process

The admission process to the School of Nursing requires two steps:

Step 1: Academic Clearance

- Fulfill academic credential requirements.
- Take HESI A2 exam.
- Applicant will receive a letter granting provisional acceptance upon completing Step 1.

Step 2: Submit required clinical documentation for Exxat Compliance.

Step 1: Academic Clearance

Applications and supporting documents should be submitted by **June 15** of the admission year for timely consideration. The following cognate courses are required for admission into the BSN (Pre-Licensure) program. Please provide the grade, semester, and year of each course, or indicate if you are currently enrolled in any of them:

The **Health Education Systems, Inc. (HESI) Admission Assessment (A2)** is an entrance exam required for all BSN (Pre-Licensure) applicants. To be considered for admission, applicants must achieve a minimum score of 75% or higher in each of the following areas:

- English Language
- Math
- Science

The HESI A2 exam is available in 190 countries and can be taken with remote proctoring through ProctorU. To register for the exam, please visit <https://www.proctoru.com/portal/elsevier-hesi>.

Step 2: Exxat Compliance

The School of Nursing has partnered with Exxat, a cloud-based platform used to track and manage clinical requirements. This partnership streamlines the process, ensuring it is secure, efficient, and convenient for students.

The following requirements are managed through Exxat:

- Background check
- Drug screen
- Physical examination
- Immunizations: TB (Tuberculosis), MMR1 and MMR2 (Measles, Mumps, Rubella), T-dap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis), Varicella (VAR), and HBV (Hepatitis B)
- American Heart Association Healthcare Provider BLS certification

Please complete **background check** and **drug screen** between **July 1 and August 15**. All other EXXAT requirements must be submitted and approved in the system before the first day of the semester.

Important Notes:

- During the order placement, you will need to provide personal identifying information for security and compliance purposes. Ensure all information is accurate and complete to avoid delays.
- The background check and drug test are non-refundable and paid directly to Exxat.

Full admission to the BSN (Pre-Licensure) Program is contingent upon acceptable completion of steps 1 and 2.
