Starting Fall 2022, the School of Population Health, Nutrition and Wellness will offer an online MHA program that prepares healthcare professionals to fulfill the demands of the ever-changing healthcare system as managers, administrators and leaders in various private and government healthcare settings. The program is devoted to improving health services delivery in the United States and globally.

PROGRAM LENGTH

- 40 semester credits, plus 2–5 credits of practicum
- 100 percent online
- Can be completed in two years or less with a maximum limit of six years for part-time students

APPLICATION DEADLINE

- August 1

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- At least a bachelor's degree and satisfy one of the following:
 - » Have an overall GPA of at least 2.60 in undergraduate courses
 - » Have a GPA of at least 2.75 on the last 50 percent of undergraduate courses
 - » Have a graduate GPA of at least 3.00 on 8-semester credits or more earned in courses graded A–F
 - » Hold a previous master's degree
- Two letters of recommendation
- Statement of purpose
- Minimum TOEFL score of 80 or 6.5 on the IELTS English Proficiency if language of education was not English
