

THE CERTIFICATION PROCESS FOR SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY

Earn your Master's degree from a CAA-accredited program.

1. Graduate

Take the Praxis Exam for Speech-Language Pathology before, during, or after applying and pass.

2. Praxis

Turn in your application for your C's to ASHA (Certificate of Clinical Competence in Speech-Language Pathology - CCC-SLP).

3. Apply

By choosing your ASHA membership with your certification you are able to enjoy member benefits.

4. Join

Choose your mentor(s) and make sure that they currently are certified through ASHA.

5. Clinical Fellowship

Successfully finish your Clinical Fellowship with at least 36 weeks and 1,260 hours.

Fill out your Clinical Fellowship Report and Ratings Form (SLPCF) alongside your mentor(s).

6. Submit Form

Be sure your mentor(s) sign all the required spots. Then submit your SLPCF to ASHA.

7. Review Period

It can take up to 6 weeks from when all your documentation is received. Once all documents are received, reviewed and approved, certification is granted.
