Andrews University is providing the following information about student complaints procedures, in compliance with <u>U.S. Congressional House Rule (HR) 668.43</u> (b) and U.S. Department of Education (USDOE) rules that an institution offering distance education must "provide its students or prospective students with contact information for filing complaints with its accreditor and with its State approval or licensing entity and any other relevant State official or agency that would appropriately handle a student's complaint."
