ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Official high school transcript with 2.5 or higher GPA, or GED certificate with minimum 450 on 5 sections and no score lower than 410
- ACT or SAT scores if high school completed in the United States within the last 3 years
- Official transcripts from all colleges or universities attended with 2.5 or higher GPA
- English language proficiency test scores when first language is not English and less than four years of high school where English was the language of instruction
- Students in United States without documentation are welcome
