


Learning Hub Quick Reference Guide: voki



<p>□ What is Voki</p>	<p>Information: Create fun and unique Voki characters that speak in many languages.</p>
<p>□ What could I use Padlet for in my course</p>	<p>Information: Here are some ideas for using a Voki in your course</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Send a message to your students in a unique way 2. Have students create voki's to introduce themselves to each other
<p>□ How do I sign-up for Padlet</p>	<p>How to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Go to https://voki.com 2. Click on Register 3. Create you username and password
<p>□ How do I create a Voki</p>	<p>How to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Login and the page will open to the spot to add your own Voki 2. Click on Create a New Voki <div data-bbox="483 703 1156 1255" style="border: 1px solid gray; padding: 10px;"> </div> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Select the look of your avatar, hair, and mouth <div data-bbox="581 1312 893 1402"> </div> b. Select clothing <div data-bbox="581 1449 787 1543"> </div> c. Select extras <div data-bbox="581 1585 779 1680"> </div> <p>Click the x to close the creation of the avatar</p> <div data-bbox="527 1774 1063 1858" style="border: 1px solid gray; padding: 5px;"> <p style="text-align: center;">Customize Your Character x</p> </div>

- d. Use the phone to add a voice to your avatar
- e. Type the message you want the avatar to speak
- f. Speak into the computer microphone to record the message



You can play the message back. Choose also the accent/language you want your avatar to speak.

- g. Choose the back ground you want the avatar to stand in front of
- h. Choose the color of player you want to be around the avatar
- i. Use the color scales to modify the look of your avatar


Click Publish when you are done

3. Name your voki/scene
4. Click save
5. Close the pop-up

□ **How do I embed my Voki into Moodle**

How to:

1. Copy the embed code that show once you close the pop-up



2. Go into Moodle
3. Turn editing on
4. Add a label in the Weekly/Topic area you would like the padlet to be placed
5. Click on the Toolbar Toggle icon



6. Click on Edit HTML icon



7. The HTML source editor will open and past in the embed code from padlet
8. Click update

Click Save and return to course
