Policies and Regulations

- To be placed on the waiting list, this application must be completed and submitted with a non-refundable application fee of **twenty dollars**.
- Your rent account must be current if you are moving into a more expensive apartment or house.
- Once you have accepted a new assignment, you are required to pay the \$100.00 non-refundable cleaning fee for the new apartment/house. This is not to be confused with the non-refundable cleaning fee you paid on your current residence.
- You will have one week (seven days) to move during which time we will continue to charge you at your current rental rate. When you have moved and turned in the keys to the old apartment/house, we will stop the rent on that apartment/house and start the rent on the new apartment/house. If you take longer than seven days, you will be charged for both apartments/houses.
- Once you are moved completely out of the old apartment/house, you will need to schedule a check-out appointment with the office. Any damage to the apartment/house will be charged as additional rent to your account and your current damage deposit will be transferred to the new apartment/house.
- Piano's must be moved with great care. Damages to the apartment or building during moving become the resident's responsibility. To have a piano or organ in any apartment other than a ground floor apartment, you must hire a professional moving company that carries liability insurance to move the piano into the apartment and out of the apartment. A copy of the receipt must be given to our office. Failure to follow this policy will result in a fine of \$150.00.
