

You made it! Remember, per your Lease Agreement:

1. You will have 7 days to move out after graduation.
2. If you stay longer than 7 days, \$10/day will be charged in addition to your rent.
3. You must pay rent for every day you are here...including the day of graduation and all others.



Please Note: If you have a balance of \$50 or more after the 10th of the month, you will receive a late fee and a hold will be placed on your account.

It is summer and people are out running, walking, playing sports and riding bikes/skateboards. Parents, please remind your children that riding bikes/skateboards near the apartments is VERY dangerous for them and for someone who may
