

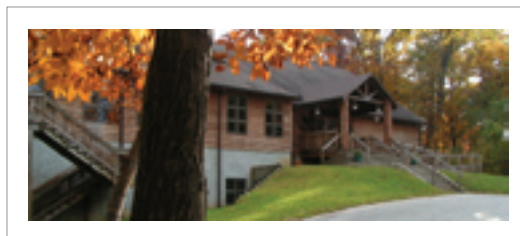
## Maple Lodge

This building is great for small groups looking for a home style setting. Full linen service is provided for all beds. There are a total of 12 beds that can sleep up to 18 people. Youth groups may request this building without linen, for a reduced rate. Features include:

- Living area with gas fireplace
- Kitchen with refrigerator, stove, sink, microwave, toaster, a selection of kitchen utensils and dishes
- 12 folding chairs and two six foot folding tables are available to set up in the living area.
- Bedroom one has two twin beds, and shares a bath with room two.
- Bedroom two has a queen bed and shares a bath with room one.
- Bedroom three and four each have a double bed and a twin bed. They share a bathroom.

There are three additional bedrooms in the basement with a separate outside entrance. There is no direct access from the upper floors. All three rooms share a bathroom.

- Bedroom five and six each have a double bed and a twin bed.
- Bedroom seven has a queen bed.



**M**t. Aetna Camp and Retreat Center is a facility dedicated to supporting Christian ministries by providing them a place to regroup, reconnect and relax in the splendor of God's woodlands.

**W**e have cabins and guest rooms to sleep up to 200, a cafeteria that seats 175, and meeting rooms for groups large and small.

## Ivy Lodge

### Dining hall

- Seats 176 at 22 five foot round tables, eight to a table. Chairs are padded, vinyl covered.
- White linen table clothes are available for a fee.
- Two highchairs and five booster seats
- Wood burning fire place
- Minimal sound system w/mic and CD player
- Piano



### Meeting room

- Seats 200 on padded, fabric covered chairs
- Wood burning fire place
- Sound system w/2 mic's, CD player, and double tape deck
- Screen with overhead, slide and LCD projectors
- 35" TV, DVD player, VHS player
- White board with markers
- 6' and 8' tables available for displays
- Piano and organ
- Lecturn
- The room can be set up with 16 tables in a seminar format with four chairs on one side and one on each end for a total of 96 attendees.
- Baptismal tank available



### Guest rooms (1-6)

- One queen bed with all linen provided
- Private bath with shower



## Nature Center

This building is open to the public on Saturday afternoons from 2:00 to 5:00 PM. Rental groups may not use the building during those hours.

### Chesapeake room

- Seats 50 on padded, fabric covered chairs.
- Screen with overhead, slide and LCD projectors
- 35" TV, DVD player, VHS player
- Flip chart
- 6' and 8' tables available for displays
- Piano
- Lecturn
- The room can be set up with 5 tables in a seminar format with four chairs on one side and one on each end for a total of 30 attendees.
- Wildlife displays of animals from the mid-Atlantic region



### Rhino room

- Seats 45 on padded, folding chairs
- 35" TV, DVD player, VHS player
- White board with markers
- 6' and 8' tables available for displays
- Lecturn
- The room can be set up with 6 tables in a seminar format with four chairs on one side and one on each end for a total of 36 attendees.
- Wildlife displays

### World wildlife room

- Wildlife displays
- Bird observation room with one-way glass.

## Cedar & Walnut Lodges

These are rustic meeting rooms. Cedar seats about 30, and Walnut about 50.



## Cabins

### Standard (1-8, 13-20)

- Sleeps nine, eight in bunks, one on a cot.
- No linen provided. Guests should bring their own bed linen, pillows and towels.
- Heated
- Private shower stall
- Private toilet stall
- Sink
- Laundry tub



### Handicap accessible (8-12)

- Same as standard with the following differences:
- Sleeps six, four in bunks, two on a cots
- Ramp access to porch
- Extra large shower and toilet stalls

## Oak Lodge

Family style guest rooms with full linen service. Three rooms on first floor, with two on second floor.

- Room 21 has a queen bed and a twin bed. The room has a private shower room and a separate toilet/sink room.
- Room 22 has a double bed and three twin beds. It shares a bath area with room 23.
- Room 23 has a queen bed and share a bath area with room 22.
- Room 24 has a queen bed and twin bunks. It shares a bathroom with room 25.
- Room 25 has a queen bed and shares a bathroom with room 24.
