A Michigan Conference pastor working in the cities of Saginaw-St. Charles is this year's recipient of the Doctor of Ministry Excellence in Research award. Robert Quillin was recently recognized for his project, "Developing Jewish Awareness Seminars: A Model Implemented in Adventist Churches in Michigan."

Dr. Quillin has 16 years' experience as a teacher and administrator in denominational schools in New England and Michigan, and has served for 28 years as a pastor.
