## New Cohorts Forming for 2012 and 2013

- A new cohort is forming now for the Pastoral Ministry (Spanish) concentration; the first intensive will be in September of 2012. **This cohort is essentially full; when the limit of 28 is reached, any remaining applications will be placed on a waiting list in case an opening develops.**
- Two international cohorts will be launched in 2012: one in Sagunto, Spain, for the Spanish Union (to study a Pastoral Ministry concentration), and the other at Zaoksky University in Russia for the Euro-Asia Division (Leadership concentration).
- **Coming in 2013:** new cohorts for Leadership, Chaplaincy Ministry, Health Care Chaplaincy, and the Evangelism & Church Growth concentrations (all NAD, English-speaking).
