#### Apply now for cohorts forming in 2014

- Organizational Leadership is a new concentration preparing church organizational leaders such as presidents, vice-presidents for administration, ministerial and other directors for excellence in their service. The cohort launches with an intensive in Southeastern California starting on January 21, 2014. The application deadline is November 26, 2013.
- A new concentration for chaplains with dual-track intensives is scheduled March 31 April 15, 2014 (application deadline January 31, 2014). Chaplains specializing in health care will have a separate-but-concurrent track in the first and fourth years of their program. - The <u>Discipleship and Biblical Spirituality</u> concentration launches a new cohort in February 2014; application deadline is **November 29, 2013**.
