### Apply now for cohorts forming in 2014

- [Organizational Leadership](#) is a new concentration preparing church organizational leaders such as presidents, vice-presidents for administration, ministerial and other directors for excellence in their service. The cohort launches with an intensive in Southeastern California starting on January 21, 2014. The application deadline is **November 26, 2013**.
- **A new concentration for chaplains** with dual-track intensives is scheduled March 31 – April 15, 2014 (application deadline **January 31, 2014**). Chaplains specializing in health care will have a separate-but-concurrent track in the first and fourth years of their program.
