New Director Welcomed to the DMin Program




Dr. Bruce Bauer has taught in the Department of World Mission at the Seminary for many years, and is currently the chair of that department. In addition to his work at the Seminary, he has given years of mission service in Southeast Asia. His wife, Linda, has also had a role in the DMin program, serving as one of the technical editors for DMin project manuscripts for international cohorts. Spring Commencement at Andrews

Stephen Yeagley Receives Award



In addition to a special certificate, the award also involves a monetary acknowledgement of the honoree's accomplishment.

This year's award goes to Stephen Yeagley, for his project entitled *"Teaching Media Literacy as a Pastoral Skill for Seventh-day Adventist Seminary Students."*
